Minutes of the SAAC NW meeting 19 May, 2002

Presidents Report President Larry Cockerham brought the meeting to order at 6:15 P.M. Larry expressed his appreciation for everyone that attended, we have a great turn-out. Larry introduced a friend of his, Mr. Dave Smith, who was present for the first time at tonight's meeting.

Vice Presidents Report Mark Pendergrass mentioned that they had a quick track day meeting before tonight's meeting to discuss any last minute problems. Mark talked about the up-coming All Ford swap meet and car show at the Hillsboro Fair Grounds on June 1st.
